2025 Bulldog Beat Scholarship Auditions Video Audition Process - Due March 1, 2025

Thank you for your interest in the Bulldog Beat Scholarship Auditions for the 2025-2026 school year. The Bulldog Beat is the top scholarship ensemble at Fresno State, paying \$6000 per student and is only open to full-time students at Fresno State, regardless of your major. This ensemble includes: 8 Saxophones (4 Alto, Tenor and Bari), 8 Trumpets, 4 Mellophones, 8 Trombones, 2 Bass Guitars, 2 Lead Guitars, 2 Pianists and 4 Drum Set players. The musicians assigned to this ensemble perform at a wide variety of events including volleyball, basketball and football games, as well as other special events and are on-call for the President of Fresno State. The Beat also travels around the state of California on an annual recruiting tour. As a member of the Bulldog Beat, participation in the Bulldog Marching Band is mandatory and attendance at all scheduled Bulldog Beat events is required.

The first step to the audition process is to go online to download the Audition Packet, found on the Fresno State Bands website. When it is time to submit your video, please complete this form - Bulldog Beat and submit your audition video. A link to the audition registration is also found on the QR code below.

Students who also intend to major in music at Fresno State should register at the Fresno State School of Music Website to secure an audition time for admittance into the Department of Music. Auditions will be held on March 8th, in person, and each studio professor will determine admittance to the music program at Fresno State. This audition is required for all incoming Music Majors and is separate from this process.

Bulldog Beat Audition Process

Students must prepare the following for a successful audition:

- 1. Be prepared to play the specific audition packet of etudes for your instrument.
- 2. Be prepared to improvise to a recording. (See more below)
- 3. Be prepared to perform the following major scales (starting on the specific notes below) and chromatic scale:

Saxophones – G Major (1 octave), D Major (2 octaves), A Major (1 octaves), Bb Major (2 octaves), Eb Major (1 octave). Chromatic Scale: practical range of the instrument, both Etudes, Improvisation (see below).

Trumpet – Bb Major (2 octaves), Eb Major (1 octave), Ab Major (2 octaves), C Major (2 octaves), G Major (2 octaves). Chromatic Scale: practical range of the instrument. both Etudes, Improvisation (see below) **Potential lead Trumpets should demonstrate range during the scales**

Mellophone – F Major (1 octave), Bb Major (2 octaves), Eb Major (1 octave), C Major (2 octaves), G Major (2 octaves). Chromatic Scale: practical range of the instrument, both Etudes, Improvisation (see below) **Potential lead Mellophones should demonstrate range during the scales**

Trombones – F Major (2 octaves), Bb Major (2 octaves), Eb Major (1 octave), C Major (2 octaves), G Major (2 octaves). Chromatic Scale: practical range of the instrument, both Etudes, Improvisation (see below) **Potential lead Trombones should demonstrate range during the scales**

Guitars – Major Scales (up to 3 flats and sharps). Both Etudes, Improvisation (see below), <u>and a brief recording of your choosing to accompany that shows off your maximum ability.</u>

Drum Set - Prepare the Drum Set packet and include <u>a brief recording of your choosing to accompany that shows off your maximum ability.</u>

Keyboard - Perform the improvisation and <u>a brief recording of your choosing to accompany that shows off your maximum ability.</u>

Improvisation - All auditionees are required to demonstrate their ability to improvise as well. <u>Use this link for your improvisation segment, performing for a minimum of 60 seconds.</u>



Play each pattern 4 times.






Up Tempo Rock








Jazz

7/8 Linear Rock/Funk


Play the 2 bar pattern twice then solo for 4 bars in 7/8 (repeat).



Bell Pattern Variations








Rhythmic Soloing

Orchestrate this 8 bar rhythm pattern around the drums while utilizing your double bass drum pedal (repeat).












Song or Loop

Drum to a song or loop (player choice). * 2-3 minutes. Bring the track with you to the audition on your phone, laptop, ipod, ipad, etc.).



*Do not record yourself playing to the track. You'll be performing it live during the audition process. Your selection should show off your strengths as a player, musician and performer.
